Who we are - Yasmin Sayyed, Founder

Yasmin was born and raised in Germany by her Palestinian father & Greek mother, letting her think multinational and open minded from the beginning.

Horses have always been her passion, yet before turning them into a career, she studied fashion design and later owned several Italian Restaurants with her husband, first in Germany and later in Mallorca.

Following the break up of the relationship she ended up in Dubai in 2004, where she spent the first 9 years riding in an endurance stable for HH Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum. After the third accident, which led to her not being able to ride for a year, she quit the racing sport and worked as a manager for different stables in UAE as well as horse trainer and riding instructor.

Salambo was her first rescue horse in 2013 who she took in to care for him in his final days. He miraculously recovered and is still with Yasmin!

From there on, more horses have followed, all horses that were left in her care, abandoned or sick, old horses with no other place to go. Yasmin, who is single and lives in Abu Dhabi with her cats and a rooster, now dedicates her life to giving these animals a few last years in dignity, at the same time educating people on animal welfare.

SALAMBO

The 22-year-old Warmblood who's been with Yasmin since 2014 and suffers from Motor Neuron Disease. He needs a lot of Vitamin E and other supplements.



MONTGOMERY

The 26-year-old snow white warmblood used to be a Grand Prix show jumper who would not have survived if Yasmin hadn't taken him last summer. He has debilitating Arthritis, yet returned to being bright and content. He eats like 10 horses!



OCEAN

is a beautiful Arabian endurance mare. She had a fractured leg, yet remains one of the softest and kindest horses who brings harmony into the Arabian herd and after some months of recovery slowly starts to carry children.

Currently, the project looks after
17 horses and 17 cats in our direct care!

Teaching children

Teaching the next generation about the proper care of animals, about self-confidence, love and respect for others is our main goal and at the same time our main source of income to support the rescue project. Whilst many of our horses can no longer be ridden by adults, they can still teach children and teenagers valuable life lessons.





Current situation

SPONSORS FOR FEED, SUPPLEMENTS, AC

Currently, all our horses are stabled at Dhabian Equestrian Club in Abu Dhabi. Tina al Qubaisi is a great supporter of our project and provides stabling at a reduced rate. However, we need to provide our own feed, farrier etc and pay our staff and veterinary costs. With the majority of our horses being old or injured, they require special care and high quality feed, which is expensive. With summer approaching, we also urgently need to cover the stable and install air conditioning asap.

4 tons of good quality hay
2900 kg of hard feed
60 bales of wood shavings

SUPPLEMENTS

We need every month:
5 kg Vitamin E
10 kg electrolytes
150 l sunflower oil
